Life Membership

- 1) Those who want to be a member of ^{The} OSOS should apply through proper Performa in Annexure I of constitution.
- 2) It should be properly filled in and electronically sent to secretary OSOS for scrutiny.
- 3) At the same time they have to send the fees for life membership e.g. Rs.2500+GST 18 % (Rs. 450)=Rs. 2950/- as on January 2024.
- 4) They have to send the money to the account of Punjab National Bank.
- 5) The secretary and treasurer must verify the member's validity by scrutinizing the form and submission of subscription fees.
- 6) Valid membership should put to the EC every month for its approval.
- 7) All the names approved by the EC should be put before the annual general body for ratification.
- 8) The ratified member must get registration number and identity card duly signed by president and secretary
- 9) The identity card of member must be renewed in 15 years.
- 10) The post graduate students, to be a member should follow the same procedure and in addition they should attach a certificate from the HOD of medical college in support of ensuing medical study in ophthalmology.
- 11) The subscription is Rs. 2000+GST 18 % (Rs. 360) =Rs. 2360/- as on January 2024.
- 12) The subscription of life membership must be changed by EC whenever it is necessary along with GST subject to ratification by annual general body.
- 13) Membership fees must be changed in every 2 years by the EC subject to confirmation by annual general body. This is because of the devaluation of money and to improve the financial condition of society.

Delegate Fees for Conference

- 1) The delegation fees should be fixed before the conferences.
- 2) A tariff list for the conference should be provided by the LOC following a thorough discussion among them
- 3) The organizing secretary and organizing committee chairman must produce the tariff list in EC, as specially called by the secretary with president's permission.
- 4) The tariff list is so fixed that, it must include 18% GST.
- 5) The amount so taken out after G.S.T must be round off to nearest 100.
- 6) There are no issues or payment confusions because the payment is processed electronically.
- 7) After the tariff is approved by EC it should be out before annual general body for approval.
- 8) Tariff list must change every year depending on the financial condition of market if annual general body approves.
- 9) Presently as on 2024 the tariff list is as follows:-

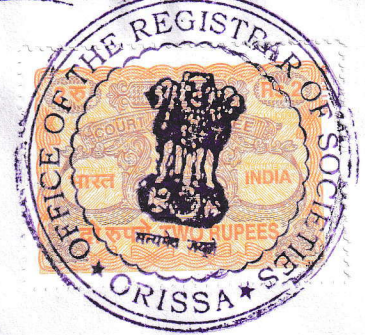

- 10) The regular registration is 25% extra to the early bird and late or spot must be 50% extra to the regular registration.
- 11) The registration cannot be changed to any other name. In special condition EC may take some decision for change along with LOC.
- 12) All cancellation registration up to the regular date is 50% subject to approval by EC & LOC.
- 13) No cancellation of registration once the last date has started.
- 14) All the rules of annual conference is applicable to midterm conference.
- 15) The registration fee of midterm conference is 1/3rd of annual conference.
- 16) President of ^{The} OSOS must be exempted from registration fees but must register.
- 17) Guest faculty from outside the state and country must be exempted from registration as per the decision of EC and LOC.
- 18) As per Jan 2024 five member for annual and two members for mid-con should be exempted from registration fees. But their name must be registered with a note of exemption from registration fees.
- 19) Members who received the oration award must be exempted from registration fees.
- 20) The members who received life time achievement award should also be exempted from registration fees.
- 21) Number of registration and the amount, person exempted from registration fees should be intimated to the secretary by the treasurer with consultation with LOC within one week of conference.

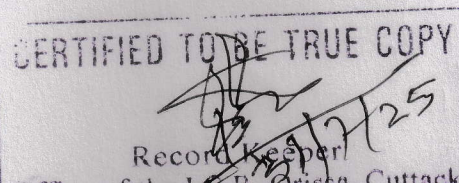

Award

1. The Post Graduate thesis must be an original prospective study conducted in Odisha. Studies that have direct or indirect impact on ophthalmology practice will be preferred. PG/DNB students must have institutional ethics committee approval for the study.
2. The award will be open all PG and DNB students who are registered for the PG/DNB training course in Odisha. The award will be open to the final year PG/DNB students only. Students who have passed in the preceding year of the competition can also apply provided they have applied for the award in the earlier year. This is to ensure students applying for the award have completed their thesis work.
3. To apply the PG/DNB students must submit their thesis as a full text manuscript of not more than 3000 words.
4. A screening committee comprising of 5 members will be entrusted with the job of reneing the applications for the award. The committee consists of
 - Scientific Committee chairperson of Odisha Ophthalmological Society (Chair)
 - President of ^{the} Odisha Ophthalmological Society
 - Campus head of L.V Prasad Eye Institute, Bhubaneswar
 - Two nominated members who have been former students of Professor KC Padhy, Nominated members will be selected from the following list of former post-graduates who enrolled as PG when Prof Padhy was Head of Department of Ophthalmology, SCB Medical College, Cuttack. They include 1. Arundhati Anshu, 2. Shailaja Nair, 3. Jayangshu Sengupta, 4. Anita Hota, 5. Sujit N. Mohapatra, 6. Suryasnata Rath, 7. Krishna K. Pattnaik, 8. Raja Agarwal, 9. Pranati Chaudhury, 10. Jayashree Mohanty.
 - Committee will score the manuscript based on originality, novelty, quality of manuscript and its impact in ophthalmology.
 - Five shortlisted PG/DNB students will be given registration waiver by OSOCON to present their study as oral podium presentation at annual OSOCON every year. The winner of the award will be decided at the OSOCON by the panel of judges as decided by the scientific committee.

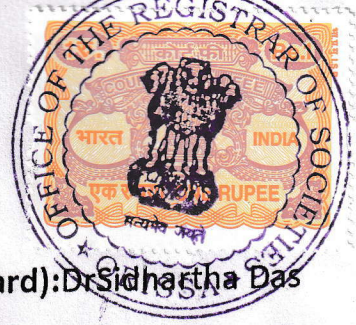

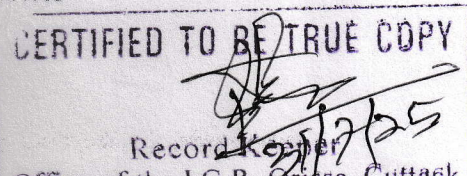


- The awards will be presented during the annual conference (OSOCON).

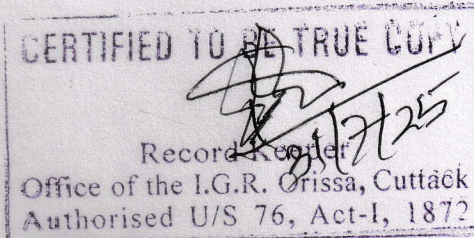
